The SE Section New Horizons Scholarship may be used to attain any level of flight certificate or rating.

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS (page 1 of 2)

1. Applications shall be accepted from members of The Southeast Section Ninety-Nines. Please be sure to include your membership number on the Official Application.
 2. Application submission: Please submit your **FULLY COMPLETED** application packet electronically to NewHorizonScholarship@SESection99s.org.
 3. The application shall require information about an applicant's aviation background, aviation goals, and specific plans for the use of the scholarship.
 4. The applicant shall be an active member of The Ninety-Nines® for one year prior to submitting application for the New Horizons Scholarship.
 5. The scholarship application shall be signed either in ink or electronically to attest that the information contained therein is true and correct.
 6. Scholarship winner will be notified within 8 weeks of the submission deadline.
 7. All award money will be paid to a flight school or flight instructor.
 8. The recipient must use the funds for the scholarship within 14 months from the official notification of receiving the scholarship.
 9. Continuation of funding is dependent on uninterrupted active membership with The Ninety-Nines® during the scholarship award period.

- How you plan to support the mission of The Ninety-Nines®?
- How are you active in The Ninety-Nines®?
- What you feel uniquely qualifies you for this scholarship?
- How do you plan to fund the remain training if these funds do not cover all the cost?
